

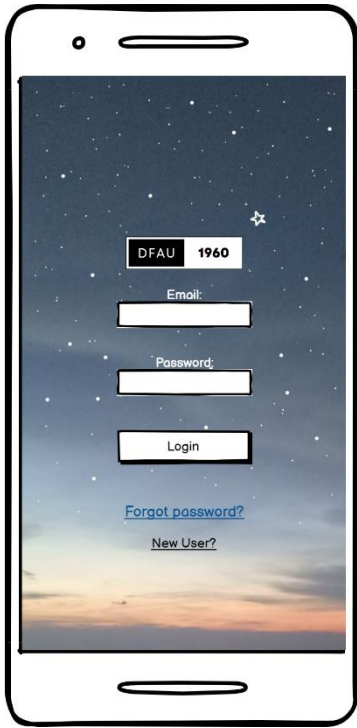
DFAU Alumni Project

DFAU High School's Class of 1960 will be hosting a reunion in July 2023. The SILS Consulting Group have created an application titled DFAU 1960 to facilitate their endeavors in event planning, memory archiving, and social networking. We specifically adopted a night sky themed color scheme for the login page and certain tabs to evoke a feeling of nostalgia and timeliness. The application is divided into five tabs: Events, Messages, Gallery, Calendar, and Legacy. We will elaborate the purpose and features of each tab in the upcoming paragraphs.

Upon launching DFAU 1960, the user will be taken to a login page where they are prompted to enter their email and password (W1). A option to retrieve lost password is also available. If the user is currently unregistered, they can click the "New User" button to create an account. Once they click it, they will be taken to a sign-up page (W2).

As mentioned, the application is divided into five tabs. The first tab is the Events page (W3). The alumni have specifically requested for the application to include a feature that would allow them to remain informed about meet-ups and other events. Hence, upon logging in, users will land at the Events page, which mirrors a social media feed where any alumni can post reminders of old events or invitations to new events. The second tab of five is the Messages page (W4). Given that the alumni are an interconnected bunch, we have created a chatroom for them to remain in touch with fellow classmates. The third tab of five is the Gallery page (W5). The alumni have preserved a backlog of pictures throughout the years commemorating celebrations in the past. They specifically requested for us to implement a feature that would allow them to store these images, and the Gallery page does just that. The fourth tab is the Calendar page (W6), which serves as a timeline for alumni to add major life milestones to. The fifth tab is the Legacy

page (W7), which commemorates the twenty deceased alumni at the time of the application's creation. Users can add more deceased members to the Legacy page in the future.



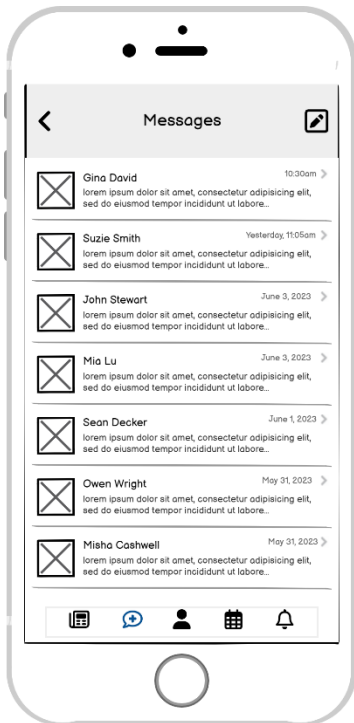
W1: Log In



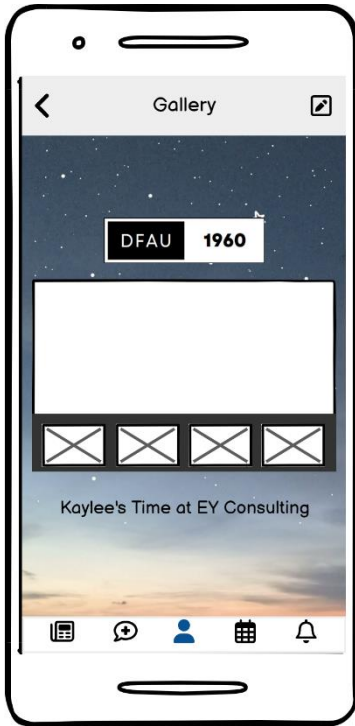
W2: Sign-Up



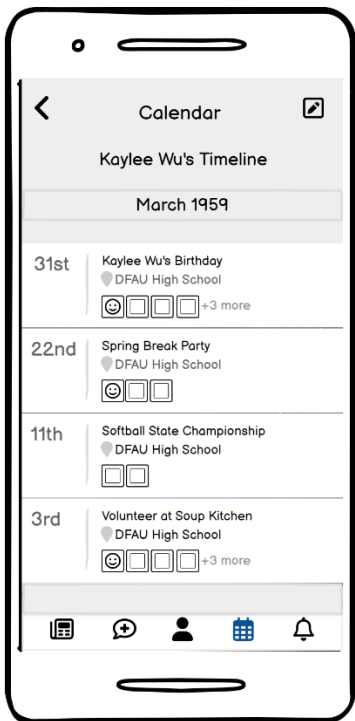
W3: Events



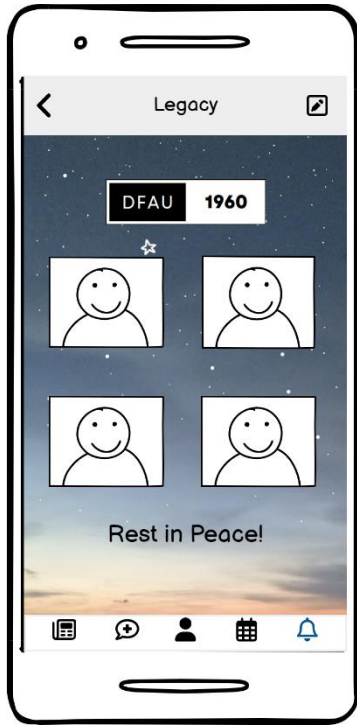
W4: Messages
